Krasnoyarsk

Krasnoyarsk is located 4065 kilometers from Moscow along the Trans-Siberian railway. It takes about 2 days and 10 hours to get there from Moscow by train and about 4.5 hours by plane.



Siberian Federal University was founded by merging 5 major Krasnoyarsk institutions of higher education.

November 4, 2006 The Prime Minister of Russia Mikhail Fradkov signed a decree to rename Krasnoyarsk State University into "Siberian Federal University" merging it with the following educational institutions: Krasnoyarsk State Architectural and Construction Academy, Krasnoyarsk State Technical University and the State University of Nonferrous Metals and Gold.





Structure and management

Eugene A. Vaganov has been the Rector of Siberian Federal University since its establishment.

The President of the University is **Alexander V. Uss**, Full Professor of Law, Board Chairman of Legislative Assembly of the Krasnoyarsk territory.

Among the members of the University Board of Trustees are representatives of large companies, politicians and scientists. The Chairman of the Board is **Dmitry Medvedev**, the Prime Minister of Russia.

International collaboration

- There are 143 MoUs and MoAs on international cooperation between SibFU and universities from 34 countries, as well as 7 programs accredited by European Council on Business Education.
- There are 380 international students of all levels (Bachelor, Master, Doctoral and Internship programs) from 23 countries currently studying at the SibFU. The largest numbers of students come from China and CIS countries – Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan. Other students come from Nigeria, Ecuador, Vietnam, Australia, etc. Exchange students from Germany, Japan, Czech Republic and Spain come on a regular basis.
