The National library of the Republic of Kazakhstan in Almaty hosted a presentation of the book "The great composer of the Turkic world Dina Nurpeisova", published in Kazakh, Russian, Turkish and English languages dedicated to the 160th anniversary of the birth of the dombra player, composer, figure of Kazakh culture.

An international research project aimed at promoting the personality of kuishi at the international level was commissioned by the regional center for scientific and methodological organization of folk art and cultural leisure services of the Department of culture, archives and documentation of Atyrau region.

Within the framework of the project, implemented under the leadership of the honored artist of the Republic of Kazakhstan, kuishi Aigul Ulkenbaeva, along with the archives of the country, trips to the state archives of Uzbekistan and Russia are organized, interesting information about Dina's life is collected, systematized and published for the first time. For the first time, the materials obtained during the search for materials from the state archives were also included.

The round table was held by the scientific adviser of the project, teacher of Atyrau university named after Kh.Dosmukhamedov, candidate of art history Bakhyt Turmagambetova.

The event was attended by well - known scientists in the field of culture and art, artists, musicologists, well-known traditional performers. The presentation ribbon was cut by the rector of the Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory, kuishi, conductor Arman Zhudebayev and deputy chairman of the board of the union of writers of Kazakhstan, writer, publicist Mereke Kulkenov.
